

Terms and Privacy Policy

1. This service abides by the Portuguese Data Protection Law.
2. No user data will be disclosed to third parties, except when explicitly demanded by the portuguese authorities for criminal and legal purposes as provided by the Portuguese Law. In that case, the information will be supplied to the proper and authorized entities with no need to inform the user.
3. The user is required to provide email, password and the necessary credentials to access data held by the user on an external third party database. No further information is required.
4. The access to user data on a third party database is made under the user's informed consent and in the righteous and strict observance of the rules and protocols defined by the owner of that database. Any update operation on such database requires the user's knowledge and has to be triggered by an explicit order on the website.
5. Some features (such as reversibility) require the temporary storing of information from third party databases on the service's own database. However, this information remains just as long as it is needed and will not be disclosed in any circumstance.
6. Passwords and access credentials to third party databases are stored in hashed or encrypted form. The user password is known to none else than the user. Access credentials to third party databases are secured by encryption.
7. A user has no means of knowing emails from other users.
8. The user email may be used by this service for contact on any matter strictly related to the service itself. The user will not be contacted for advertisement, publicity or any other purpose extraneous to the service or website.
9. This service cannot be held responsible for any loss of privacy or for any data violation resulting from error or malfunction in hardware or software from third parties.
10. Though security is a major concern and it is enforced as far as possible, no system is absolutely immune to intrusion attempts. Thus, this service cannot be held responsible for any loss of privacy or for any data violation resulting from malicious and intentional attacks on its security.

11. This service cannot be held responsible for any loss of privacy or for any data violation resulting from error or malfunction in hardware or software on the user's side.
12. The user will not engage in intrusion attempts, attacks against the system or in any other form of abusive behavior. Any behavior contrary to the Portuguese laws or in disrespect to the moral and ethical standards of the Portuguese society is deemed as abusive.
13. The service administration reserves the right to ban abusive users with no prior warning and without their knowledge.
14. Cookies are used for improving functionality and performance. They include data about the IP address, the browser and also some additional data for session management purposes. They do not contain personal data or critical security codes. Cookies may be disabled by user, but this will affect or limit several features of the service as well as the user's experience on the website.
